BIPT finds application for fourth 3G licence to be admissible

Brussels, 10 May 2011 - On 29 April 2011, BIPT received 1 application for the fourth 3G licence. The candidate is NV/SA TELENET TECTEO BIDCO. In the meantime BIPT has found the application to be admissible.

The call for applications for the fourth 3G licence launched by BIPT on 15 March 2011 has resulted in one application. It was submitted by NV/SA TELENET TECTEO BIDCO.

The BIPT Council has established the admissibility of the application.

Therefore, chances are that a fourth 3G operator will soon enter the Belgian market, joining Belgacom, Mobistar and KPN Group Belgium. The licence could even be granted before the start of the summer.

The granting of user rights is laid down by the Electronic Communications Act and in accordance with the 3G Royal Decree. The website www.auction2011.be contains all useful information on the procedure.
